

Rules for using Harvard citations for the journal "Libertas Religiosa"

Below are instructions for writing footnotes and bibliography in the Harvard system applicable to the journal "Libertas Religiosa". For each type of source, an example of a footnote found in the text is given, as well as the full form of the bibliographic notation, which is placed at the end of the article. Below are examples of how to create footnotes and bibliographies. In red are marked fixed components of descriptions, such as punctuation marks, abbreviations, words, and in black are variable elements, depending on the source cited.
